

2026 ANNA C. PETTEYS SCHOLARSHIP

The Anna C. Petteys Scholarships are awarded annually to three outstanding senior girls from public high schools located in any of the following counties: Logan, Morgan, Phillips, Sedgwick, Washington, and Yuma. The scholarships may be used to pursue a bachelor's degree at four-year accredited colleges or universities, or accredited online competency-based universities, in the United States. They may also be used at two-year accredited colleges or universities as a first step towards a four-year degree. The Scholarship amount is \$6,000 per year, renewable, for a maximum of four years or \$24,000 during the student's accredited college tenure.

GUIDELINES FOR APPLICANTS AND SCHOOL OFFICIALS

1. Scholarship forms are to be completed by the applicant and sent to the Trust Department, Jack Petteys Memorial Foundation, PO Box 324, Brush, CO 80723. The application deadline is March 16, 2026. Applications must be received at Farmers State Bank of Brush by the deadline, or they will not be considered. Mailed applications must be postmarked by March 12 to allow time for delivery. Applications may be dropped off at Farmers State Bank of Brush, 200 Clayton St., Brush.
2. A completed application must contain all the following items:
 - a. Application form (to be completed by the student).
 - b. SAT or ACT score report. An SAT score of 1200 or ACT score of 25 is necessary to apply. Super scoring is not allowed.
 - c. Class rank and size of graduating class.
 - d. Official transcript of high school courses and grades.
 - e. A typed and signed personal letter from the applicant outlining goals and objectives for the future and giving an explanation as to her financial circumstances as they relate to attending the institution of her choice (one page maximum and 12 pt. font, please).
 - f. Two completed Personal Reference Forms with attached letters: one from school faculty and one from someone other than school personnel (e.g., doctor, minister, neighbor, employer).
3. Applicants selected as finalists will be invited for personal interviews in April.
4. The winners and their schools will be notified by May 1.
5. Recipients are not allowed to receive more than \$3,000 annually in other renewable scholarships from sources other than their college. One-time grants are not included in that total. If a recipient receives offers of more than \$3,000, she will have to turn one or more of them down or decline the Anna C. Petteys Scholarship. While the amount of scholarship monies received from the student's college is not restricted, the total amount of scholarship monies cannot exceed the cost of tuition, fees, room, and board as verified by the college.
6. Criteria for the scholarship are U. S. citizenship, academic promise, leadership, character, and a minimum score of 1200 on the SAT or score of 25 on the ACT.
