Superintendent Fraley reported that it's been a busy, productive, and positive start to the school year.

4.1 Assessment Schedule and Timeline for data from CDE

- Superintendent Fraley gave an update on assessments. Assessments of learning (CMAS, SAT) and assessments that are for learning (NWEA). NWEA assessments will begin right away and will be completed within a month. Some students have received CMAS results, the school district will receive the results at the school level toward the end of August.

- Staff met last Tuesday for a district meeting and Chartwells provided a delicious breakfast for all staff. Getting ready for students tomorrow, with more options for students with a larger menu. Will eventually be cooking meals at Yuma Middle School.

10.0 BOARD REPORTS/COMMENT


- Director Roundtree
